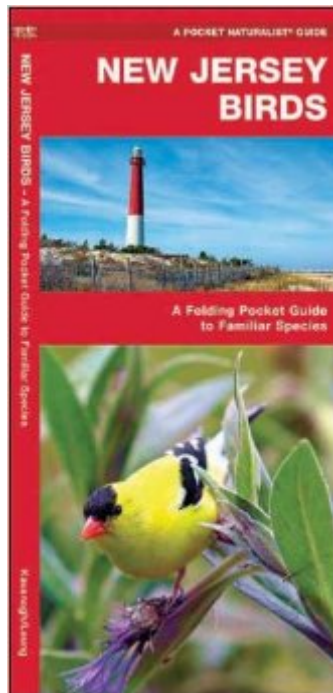

Every year, a group of birders go to Cape May, New Jersey. This booklet helps great! This booklet is great to practice with and also if taking photographs, to later look at your photos and then identify the photos as to what bird you photograph. That way you do not interrupt with your birding. In between birdwatching, you can take a close-up photo, and continue watching birds. There are many of these guides out for different places. The wide spread of birds, which are grouped by similarities, makes this a very quick and easy tool to identify birds.
