

Unfortunately i didn't notice that it was for eastern US, and i'm on the west coast, but there's still a great deal of cross coverage so i've managed to make use of it anyhow. I will be buying the pacific coast version of this book as soon as i find it.

This guide is perfect for basic flower id. The one con I have found is that the plant must actually have the flower on it in order to id it. This can be troublesome if you are trying to key out a plant in the forest that is past bloom or pre-bloom.
